

Park Rules

We have a "0" tolerance policy on our rules. These rules are for your safety and the safety of other guests. Failure to follow the rules will result in immediate removal from the park for the day or permanently.

1. You are entering private property. All visitors will obey signs, rules and follow the direction of park staff and park rangers. Failure to do so may result in removal from property. Each entrant is responsible for their actions of those in his/her party. Each entrant must check in, pay fees and sign a liability waiver prior to entering property at the park office. Failure to pay fees and sign is considered theft and trespassing.
2. Each entrant is expected to obey all State penal laws and stay on marked trails that are appropriate to the vehicle they are riding / driving.
3. The use of legal drugs which impair judgment or a controlled substance or illegal drugs is prohibited. Use of legal drugs (prescriptions) will result in removal from the park. Use, discovery of illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia will result in an arrest and permanent ban from the park and police involvement.
4. All motorcycles and ATV riders must wear a HELMET at all times while riding the vehicle. Bicycle, equestrian and skate boarding type helmets are not adequate protection. Helmets must be rated for off road motorcycle and ATV use. We recommend additional protective equipment including goggles, boots and gloves. Occupants of vehicles without a roll cages or seat belts must wear helmets. If your vehicle is equipped with a seat belt, it must be used and fastened when the vehicle is in motion.
5. NIGHT RIDING is allowed on Friday and Saturday nights until midnight. No exceptions!
6. The consumption of alcohol by any vehicle operator is prohibited on the property. Drinking prior to riding is prohibited for operators of all vehicles. You may drink alcohol in your camp but please keep it mild. We will not tolerate any drunkenness or disorderly conduct involving alcohol.
7. There are no refunds on park fees. This includes mechanical failure. We suggest that you make sure your equipment is running properly prior to arriving at the park.
8. Disruptive behavior, destruction of property or misconduct will not be tolerated.
9. No littering, please place trash in trash bins. Help keep your park clean.
10. Minors 17 or under are not allowed to enter the park by there self. Minors 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or other adult. Temporary guardianship is required if the minor is not your child. Full size vehicle drivers must hold a valid state drivers license.
11. Parents & guardians must supervise their children or minors in their care at all times. Do not allow small children to wonder off without supervision.
12. Riding in designated areas only. All entrants are required to read and follow the directions or warning on posted signs.
13. Most dogs are allowed. (NO pit bulls, chows or aggressive dogs are allowed) Owner is responsible for dog and any injuries or damage they cause. Excessive barking, unfriendly and poor behavior from dogs is not permitted. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH.
14. CHL (Concealed Handgun License) may carry handguns if they posses a current CHL license. License holders are expected to follow State laws regarding carrying handguns.
15. Firearms are not allowed to be carried on your person while on our property unless you are at the shooting range or hold a CHL. Please keep firearms in your vehicle with proper locking mechanisms to prevent accidental firing. If you are hunting or shooting at the range and carrying firearms on your ATV they must be unloaded.
16. No fireworks of any kind are allowed on property during a burn ban. Check with the office for ban status.
17. No removing or cutting trees for firewood. We sell firewood at the office.
18. Removal of items from ranch is prohibited. This includes but is not limited to trash cans, tables, benches, materials.
19. No hunting. Do not chase, harass or chase any animal they will defend themselves.
20. Speed limit in parking areas is 15 mph. Please drive slow in these areas as they are the most concentrated area for vehicles and people. No aggressive riding in parking and camping areas.
21. No playing loud music. Music must be off by 9pm.
22. Speed limit on ranch roads (red markings) is 15 mph. Speed limit on trails is 20mph. Speeds in excess of this are not recommended for safety reasons. If you choose to speed it as at your own risk. Make sure you slow down around corners and when approaching crossings.
23. All riders are responsible for safety and are to practice safe and courteous riding at all times.
24. ATV's, UTV's and motorcycles are to use the A-B access trail between Areas A & B. No riding on main road between these areas.
25. Do not ride in livestock ponds or lakes. Do not cut trees or fencing.
26. We are not responsible for injuries, accidents, damage to anybody's vehicle, person or property for any reason.
